

STONEHAVEN II – POOL & TENNIS COURT RULES

GENERAL

- The swimming pool is for the exclusive use of members of Stonehaven Phase II Homeowner's Association.
- POOL HOURS – DAYLIGHT HOURS ONLY. Pool hours are posted at the pool. Anyone found trespassing inside the fenced pool area after posted hours may be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.
- **WARNING** – The pool, clubhouse, and tennis court area is under 24 hour, high resolution video surveillance. By entering the area you agree that your images will be captured and stored electronically on digital media. Additionally, the captured images may be used to determine the individual(s) responsible for committing intentional and unintentional acts of vandalism or damage against Stonehaven II Recreation Association Property and for seeking civil restitution and for criminal prosecution of such acts.
- It is up to each and every Homeowner to abide by and enforce these rules and be responsible for their minor children's actions. If you see a Homeowner, their children or their guests breaking a rule, TELL THEM!! If you see an act of vandalism or damage to Stonehaven II Recreation Association Property, report it to the Association Manager at 864-467-1600. Be prepared to include the date and approximate time of the incident. The video surveillance system will provide the necessary evidence to seek restitution or take action against the parties involved. By doing so you will help control the Homeowner's Association costs and keep our dues as low as possible.
- There are no lifeguards at our Facilities. You are responsible for the safety and well being of your family and guests.
- Parents will be responsible for damage caused by their minor children in and around the pool, clubhouse, and tennis court area.
- The telephone is located in the storage room beside the ladies' restroom. This is for emergencies only and only dials 911. It is suggested that you unlock this room upon arrival, if it is not already opened, for phone access in case of emergency. The pool key opens this room.
- There is a limit of five (5) guests per household. Rental of the clubhouse does not increase this number, nor does it give you access to the pool area before or after normal pool hours.
- Be sure to secure the Clubhouse Main Gate to the locking side posts if you are opening the gate.

- Be sure to close and lock the Clubhouse Main Gate if you are the last one with a vehicle leaving the clubhouse area.
- Be sure the pool area gates are closed and locked upon entering & exiting the pool area. Do not prop gates open.
- The pool furniture is not for children's play time. Making forts or dragging pool furniture around the pool area on its painted surfaces or sides damages the furniture and wears out the rubber straps.

SAFETY & HEALTH

- A responsible guardian must accompany children 15 years of age and under when inside the fenced pool area. There are no exceptions to this rule.
- Parents must not send their children to the pool and expect other homeowners at the pool to supervise them.
- No glass containers of any kind are permitted in the pool area.
- No running, pushing, wrestling, rowdy behavior, or causing a disturbance in or around the pool, tennis court or clubhouse area.
- No diving/flipping or rowdy horse play of any kind.
- No bikes, skateboards, scooters, heeies or roller blades will be allowed inside the gated area of the pool or tennis court areas. Parents are responsible for their children and will be held accountable.
- Only swim diapers are permitted for children in diapers. If an accident occurs, you are responsible for contacting the Association Manager and all costs incurred for clean up and treatment of the pool.
- No food or cigarettes allowed within 6 feet of pool.
- No pets or animals in pool or tennis court area.
- Pool toys & flotation devices should not be used if the pool is crowded.
- Baby pool is for infants and toddlers only.

- Respect other homeowners by cleaning up after yourself and your guests. Use the trash containers and provided cleaning supplies to clean up the space you occupied while at the pool.
- If you are the last one to leave the pool, please lock both restrooms and storage room.
- Please do not enter the clubhouse from either restroom, even if the doors have inadvertently been left unlocked. **The alarm will sound and police will be dispatched. You will be held responsible for all false alarm fees incurred.**

LOST & FOUND – Items can be found in the storage room beside the ladies’ restroom.
